The Purchaser hereby indemnifies and holds the Seller harmless against removal fees, dismantling fees and/or delayed removal not being posted or announced whether known or unknown by the Seller. Upon failure of Purchaser to collect goods within time specified above, the Seller shall have the option in its sole discretion of removing and storing the purchased items at the expense and risk of the Purchaser or may resell the purchased items without notice at public sale or otherwise dispose of goods at the sole risk and expense of the Purchaser.
